What does Lucky Cat Haven do?

Our mission is to:

1. Facilitate societal change towards responsible cat ownership by educating individuals on the benefits of neutering, vaccinating and indoor living;
2. Socialize and find permanent homes for strays, semi-feral, and feral cats; and
3. Collaborate with other animal rescue societies on initiatives pertaining to responsible cat ownership and finding permanent homes for strays, semi-feral and feral cats.

Owner Surrenders

We understand that life circumstances change which may result in your decision to find a new home for your cat.

Lucky Cat Haven will work with you to determine how best we can assist you in finding a new home for your cat. If you decide to surrender the cat into our care, we like to meet the current caregiver to learn about the cat's personality, likes and dislikes, etc. to help us in finding the right home for the cat.

We understand this is a difficult decision for you and will endeavour to find the home that best suits your cat's requirements.

We would prefer to help an owner find a new home for their cat than to work with a cat that has been abandoned and surviving as a stray.

Dealing with an emotionally, mentally and physically traumatized cat is more draining on our resources and truly unfair to the cat.



Life as a stray or a feral cat is rough!

Given this, when a family adopts a cat from Lucky Cat Haven, we ask them to contact us if they need to re-home their cat. We also have a 30 days return policy for adopters, as we prefer having a family who is happy with their decision than to be stuck with a cat that does not fit their lifestyle. Our goal is to have a happy family and a happy cat!

Socializing an adult feral cat is time-consuming; however, it is the most rewarding work for an animal rescuer. You have taken a wild cat and taught them that humans can be trusted. Some of our adopters have been amazed to learn their lap cat was once feral.
